SCHEDULE "A"

TERMS, CONDITIONS AND PERIOD OF OFFICE OF DEPUTIES TO THE COMMISSION

Remuneration

The Deputy Commissioners shall be paid the remuneration of \$2,000.00 per day or \$200.00 per part of a day during which the Deputy Commissioners are engaged upon the said Commission, plus actual expenses approved by the Honourable the Premier and Minister for Trade, incurred in the performance of their duties.

Travel

The Deputy Commissioners to the Commission shall be entitled to business class travel in the course of their duties.

Period of office

The Deputy Commissioners are appointed for a period which ends when the Commissioner transmits his report and recommendations to the Honourable the Premier and Minister for Trade or the 30 September 2005, whichever date is the earlier.
