Thank you for your information regarding Dr Muir. Our preliminary inquiries and review of Dr Muir's file have revealed that he registered in Queensland prior to the disciplinary action which took place subsequently in the United States. Dr Muir did not disclose this disciplinary action to the Board nor did a US registration authority notify any outcome.

Nevertheless, the Board has power under the *Health Practitioners (Professional Standards) Act 1999* to apply the same sanction as imposed on a registrant by a foreign regulatory authority if the Board is of the view that action is necessary in order to meet the objects of the Act.
