FINDINGS:

There is a very large right sided extra-cerebral collection which is causing significant and quite marked pressure effect on the right hemisphere of the brain with compression of the ventricles and midline structures and movement of the midline structures towards the left. The appearances are basically similar to that seen on a previous study allowing for some rotation of the skull.
