




**ADDENDUM TO STATEMENT OF LAKSHMAN KUMAR JAYASEKERA**

1. I refer to my Statement made on 27 May 2005 which was Exhibit <sup>308</sup>~~307~~ among the Exhibits of the Bundaberg Hospital Commission of Inquiry.

3. Further to paragraph 34 of my Statement, after the doctor from Yugoslavia failed to take up the position of Director of Surgery, the position was not offered to me. No one approached me to ask if I would take the position. I felt humiliated. If I had been offered the position after it had been rejected by the doctor from Yugoslavia I ~~would~~ probably would have accepted it.
