

I gained entry into Medical School in 1968 and it was during my clinical years that I became interested in Orthopaedic Surgery. I graduated in 1973 and completed my Intern Year at the King Edward VIII Hospital, the Teaching Hospital of the University of Natal, in Durban, South Africa.

I arrived in Australia in April 1975, after securing a position as Senior House Officer in Orthopaedics at Mona Vale Hospital, Sydney. As I was interested in pursuing a career in Orthopaedic Surgery, I moved to Queensland where the prospects of me obtaining an Australian Orthopaedic Association Training Post was better and started my career in Queensland as Surgical Registrar at Townsville General Hospital. I obtained the Primary F.R.A.C.S. in 1976 and the final Fellowship (F.R.A.C.S.) in May 1980. My training posts saw me rotate to various terms at Townsville General Hospital, Royal Brisbane Hospital and the Royal Childrens Hospital. I completed the A.O.A. Training Programme in Orthopaedics in 1982 and as outlined in my Curriculum Vitae I was exposed to a wide variety of General Surgery, Trauma and Orthopaedic Surgery (Adult and children).

In December, 1982, I was appointed Director of Orthopaedic surgery at Rockhampton Base Hospital which had 402 beds and was the major referral Hospital for central Queensland. I was in charge of 44 orthopaedic beds and during my term was not only able to extend my Orthopaedic knowledge and skills but also gained valuable

experience in Administration. Surgical procedures included all aspects of Orthopaedic Surgery including Replacement Arthroplasty, Arthroscopy, Paediatric Orthopaedics, Spinal Surgery, Trauma, Hand and Microsurgery. Weekly duties included three Orthopaedic Outpatient Clinics, three Operating Sessions, Ward rounds, Tuition of Final Year Medical Students and Advanced Surgical Trainees. Resident Training Programme and Lectures to Nurses. I changed my appointment to visiting Orthopaedic Surgeon (4x3 hour sessions per week) when I commenced Locum Private orthopaedic Practice in 1985.

In September 1986, I was appointed as Visiting Orthopaedic Surgeon to Ipswich General Hospital. The Ipswich General Hospital was a three-hundred and sixty (360) bed General Hospital situated fifty (50) kilometres south-west of Brisbane and a teaching Hospital of the University of Queensland, Its services were also utilised by residents of the south-western Brisbane suburbs of Karana Downs, Anstead, Bellbowrie, Inala, Wacol and Gailes. The town of Ipswich lies at the junction of the Warrego and Cunningham Highways and the Brisbane Valley Highway is nearby. consequently a large volume of road trauma was seen at the Hospital.

My appointment to Ipswich General Hospital was for 4x3 sessions per week which was distributed as follows :

- 1 Session - Hand / upper Limb Outpatient clinic
- 1 session - Hand Theatre
- 1 Session - General Orthopaedic and Trauma Clinic
- 1 Session - General Orthopaedic and Trauma Theatre

In addition I did an Outpatient Clinic and Operating Session at 1st Military Hospital once a fortnight. However the major part of my work was in Private Practice which involved the usual consultations and three (3) operating sessions per week. I had a busy practice and do believe that I practiced Orthopaedic Surgery of a high standard. I had been involved in organising Post-Graduate Orthopaedic Education in the Ipswich area and I conducted the Orthopaedic Registrar Training Programme prior to the appointment of a Director of Orthopaedics. Together with Dr R. Ivers in Toowoomba I arranged regular clinical meetings for Registrars and Orthopaedic Surgeons from Ipswich and Toowoomba..

My Current appointment is Director of Orthopaedics (M02-2) at Hervey Bay Hospital but responsible for Orthopaedic Services for the Fraser Coast Health Service District which includes Maryborough Hospital. Since my appointment the Orthopaedic Department has evolved from 1 VMO, 1 SMO, 1 RMO to 2 VMOs, 3 SMOs, 1 PHO and 2 RMOs. Apart the administrative duties and clinical teaching I do 3 clinic and 3 operative sessions.

As part of my continuing Education in Orthopaedics since completing the A.O.A Training Programme, I regularly attended the Annual Meeting of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons, Local Orthopaedic meetings and Workshops approved by the Continuing Education Committee of the Australian Orthopaedic Association.

As the only fulltime orthopaedic specialist, there has been a role to enhance teaching and supervision of staff in the day to day management of emergency and inpatient cases.


He has regularly and enthusiastically taken on his responsibility on management committees which discuss planning strategies for the health district.
