


**RESOLVED** that:-

- (i) Dr [redacted] be approved special purpose registration under Section 135 and Section 143A to fill an area of need within the specialty of Otolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery at Cairns Health Service District from 8 December 2004 to 31 August 2005;
- (ii) conditions be imposed to enable Dr [redacted] to competently and safely undertake the approved activity pursuant to Section 141 of the Act as follows:-
  1. Dr [redacted] must undertake 12 months of "assessment under oversight" in the specialty of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery;
  2. Dr [redacted] must practise with oversight provided by two Fellows nominated by the RACS Board of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery for the term of the assessment period;
  3. Dr [redacted] must arrange for the two Fellows providing oversight to submit three monthly assessment reports to the Chairman of the Board of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery and the Censor in Chief for the term of the assessment period, with copies of the reports to be provided to the Medical Board of Queensland;
  4. Dr [redacted] must maintain a logbook for submission to the Chairman of the Board of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery and the Censor in Chief at three monthly intervals for the term of the assessment period;
- (iii) Dr [redacted] must participate in the College Maintenance of Professional Standards Programme for the term of the assessment period;
- (iv) an Information Notice be given to Dr [redacted] regarding the Board's decision.
