


SUPPLEMENTARY STATEMENT OF GAIL YVONNE DOHERTY of address known to the Queensland Nurses' Union of Employees

1. I have provided as statement to the Bundaberg Hospitals Commission of Inquiry dated 20 May 2005.
2. I have been asked to provide a supplementary statement to the Queensland Public Hospitals Commission of Inquiry concerning the content of paragraph 26 of a statement of Dr Lakshman Kumar Jayasekera dated 27 May 2005 in which Dr Jayasekera states he received a call from a Theatre Nurse to come into the hospital while a Russian Doctor was operating, using the words: "*Lucky can you come in as we have a patient who is going to die on the table*".
3. I do have a recollection of an occasion when Dr Anatole Kotlovsky was performing bowel surgery and it was taking longer than usual. I recall asking Dr Kotlovsky whether I should call Dr "Lucky" Jayasekera in, and he agreed. I then called Dr Jayasekera who attended and completed the surgery.
4. I recall that the anaesthetist was Dr Adam Butler who became concerned during the surgery and that it was arranged for Dr Martin Carter to attend so that the surgery was completed with both Dr Carter and Dr Jayasekera in attendance.
5. I deny that I said to Dr Jayasekera, when I called him to come in, that the patient was going to die. I recall saying that we needed a hand and that we were having some problems.
6. I was concerned about the length of time the operation was taking and as per my usual practice, I recall that I asked Dr. Kotlovosky if he would like me to call in Dr. Jayasekera to assist. I recall that I did so in this instance. I recall that the following day I passed my concerns re the above to my Nurse Unit Manager, Jenny White. I recall that Jenny White then had a discussion with both Dr Jayasekera and Dr. Carter regarding this matter.
7. I have been given the dates when Dr Kotlovsky worked at Bundaberg Base Hospital. From going back to the theatre records during that period of time, I

have identified that the incident was likely to be related to a procedure performed upon the patient MARCO VANBEELEN on 21st March 2002


8. I do not believe I am able to assist further in relation to this matter


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
